Ask Jesus to continue to change you to be more like Him.

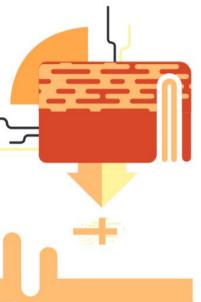
