Wednesday

- Read Together
1 Samuel 23:1-29
- Grow Together
Do you tend to run towards Jesus when you are afraid or away from Him?
- Pray Together
Thank Jesus for his peace and protection of you.

Thursday

- Watch Together
David Spares Saul's Life

- Grow Together
Describe a time that you wanted to have revenge rather than mercy. What did it feel like, what was the outcome?
- Pray Together
Ask Jesus for forgiveness for when you have sought revenge rather than mercy..

Friday

- Read Together
1 Samuel 24:1-7
- Grow Together
When have you experienced something that seemed good, but then was not? What about the other way around?
- Pray Together
Ask God to show you the good that comes from times when life doesn't seem that good.

Saturday

- Read Together
1 Samuel 24:8-27
- Grow Together
In what ways is God changing you? Where can you rely on Him better for that change?
- Pray Together
Ask Jesus to continue to change you to be more like Him.

Main Point

God's people are to trust in Him for justice and show grace to all.

Are there any differences between how Christians generally handle conflict and how the world does? Why?

What are some ways we can shower mercy and grace on others with whom we might find ourselves in conflict?
