anything, anytime!

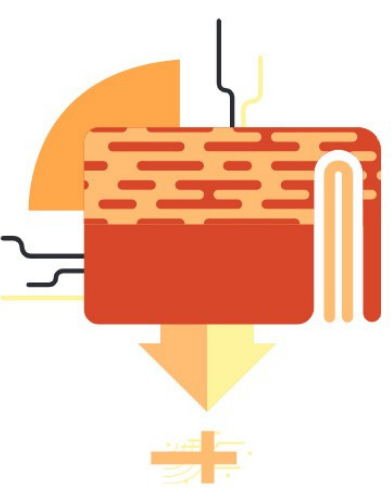
## Friday
